While enjoying an Estes Park summer home with his wife he sought light through Freemasonry at Estes Park Lodge #183. Seeking to perfect the craft he later joined Bestor G. Brown Lodge #433 of Wichita, KS and excitedly rose to meet the Midian Shrine Band's needs as their baritone.

Wilbur had no time for childhood games and quickly became an adult as World War II started dedicating him to an immeasurable service to the country in the U.S. Navy. Returning home he diligently sought knowledge; first graduating from Emporia State University and later receiving a Master of Arts Education Specialist degree from Emporia State.
